

The State of the 119<sup>th</sup> Congress


#### Current House: First Session of the 119<sup>th</sup> Congress

- Republicans currently hold a 3-seat majority (218-215).
- The House has two vacant seats currently and another to come soon:
  - Rep. Matt Gaetz (R-FL) resigned on November 13 and did not take the oath of office for the 119<sup>th</sup> Congress.
  - Rep. Mike Waltz (R-FL) resigned on January 20 to become President Trump's National Security Adviser.
  - Rep. Elise Stefanik (R-NY) is expected to resign in the coming weeks pending her confirmation to serve as the U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations.




#### Current Senate: First Session of the 119<sup>th</sup> Congress

- Republicans have a 53-47 majority.
  - Lt. Gov Jon Husted (R-OH) appointed to fill term of Vice President JD Vance.
  - Attorney General Ashley Moody (R-FL) appointed to fill term of Secretary of State Marco Rubio.
- The Democratic minority includes two independent Senators – Sens. Bernie Sanders (I-VT) and Angus King (I-ME) – who caucus with the party.




#### Legislative Activity is at an All Time Low
